CloudLinux OS 6 End Of Life

If you're running CloudLinux OS 6, you'll know that End of Life is coming in a few months (November 30, 2020). When a Linux distro reaches End of Life, it's more than the end of a long affair. It's the start of a new dangerous liaison. That's because EOL means no more vendor support, and no more operating system security patches or bug fixes.

We at CloudLinux are providing extended lifecycle support for CloudLinux OS 6 through 2024. We'll continue to patch critical elements needed for hosting, such as Apache and PHP. What's more, cPanel will continue to support CloudLinux OS 6 as part of our extended lifecycle support.

No need to move to CloudLinux OS 7 — just get our extended lifecycle support for version 6, then move directly to CloudLinux OS 8 before it ends on June 30, 2024.
